Weekend Worship: This weekend's worship theme for this, the third Sunday in Advent is titled "A Time to Rejoice". Seminarian Aaron Beckman will be preaching.

Mid-week Advent Services: This year's advent theme is titled "Isaiah Hope". This week's sermon title is "Clothed and Rebuilt" based on Isaiah 61:1-4, 8-11. The services will be held at 11am and 6:30pm. We are asking those who will be coming to the 11am Advent service to mask for the whole service. Those coming to the 6:30pm service can take off their masks once they sit down.

Sunday Morning Zoom Bible Study: Please contact Pastor Krenz if you would like to be part of this study, and he will send you the link. The time for this study is 9:30am-10am, so that people attending either Sunday worship service can either get home in time after the early service or make it to the late service. Christmas Program: While we will not be having our regular Christmas program this year, every week during Advent a few young people will be assisting with an early reading in the service, and during the children's message reciting and reading key parts of the Christmas account.
